## Declaration of consent for grant recipients

The Novo Nordisk Foundation requests certain personal information about grant recipients, including Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID) and the Danish CPR number.

Researchers registered in the non-profit organization ORCID have a digital identifier. ORCID helps to identify the scientific work of the individual researchers in the publication databases. The Foundation collects this identifier to analyse the Foundation grants and to ensure that the outputs are correctly credited to you and your work.

Researchers receiving Foundation grants registered in Denmark's Civil Registration System have a CPR number. The Foundation collects CPR numbers to analyse the Foundation grants. When the Agency has approved the analysis design, the Foundation will submit the CPR numbers to Statistics Denmark and will get access to anonymized register data for the specified purpose. Anonymity ensures that individuals cannot be identified. Further, data are only accessible in aggregated form on a research server at Statistics Denmark.
